

TROPICAL BASIC OFFSHORE SAFETY INDUCTION & EMERGENCY TRAINING (TBOSIET)



This course is the Basic Offshore Safety Induction and Emergency Training (BOSIET), customised to suit Tropical environments. This course is OPITO approved, designed and conducted according to OPITO standards.

COURSE AIM

The T-BOSIET will introduce delegates to the specific safety issues and regimes relevant to offshore installations, and to equip them with the basic emergency response knowledge and skills for travelling to and from offshore installations by helicopter in a tropical environment.

TARGET GROUP

The T-BOSIET programme is designed for personnel who are new to the offshore oil and gas industry in a tropical environment

COURSE CONTENT

Course delegates will gain a basic level of understanding and an awareness of safety & emergency procedures on offshore installations, and will be required to demonstrate their skills, knowledge & understanding in the following key areas,

Safety Induction

- Industry and Installation Overview
- Offshore Hazards
- Managing Offshore Safety
- Controlling Offshore Hazards
- Regulating Offshore Safety
- Living and Working Offshore

Sea Survival

- Evacuation
- Emergency First Aid

Helicopter Safety & Escape

- Helicopter Travel
- Helicopter Emergencies

Fire Fighting & Self Rescue

- Fire Fighting Offshore
- Self Rescue

COMPETENCY

Delegates are required to pass a theoretical and practical assessment of their competency in each of the above areas before being awarded with a course certificate, Delegates who pass the course assessment area also recorded on the OPITO Industry Database.

PRE REQUISITE

There are no pre requisites for participation on this course, however delegates must be medically fit and capable of participating fully in the course activities. Emergency response training contains physically demanding and stressful elements, and all delegates must complete a medical screening form and if necessary undergo a medical examination prior to attending the course.

METHOD OF TRAINING

This course includes theoretical and practical components, visual teaching aids, writing materials and provision of catering.

COURSE DURATION

Three (3) days.

RATIO OF THE TRAINING

40% Theory / 60% Practical
