TROPICAL FURTHER OFFSHORE EMERGENCY TRAINING (TFOET)

COURSE AIM

The aim of the T-FOET is to provide the delegates with the opportunity to practise and demonstrate emergency response skills which are not possible to practice during drills, exercises and emergency training offshore. (Refreshment)

TARGET GROUP

- · Helicopter Safety and Escape,
- · Fire Fighting and Self Rescue, and
- · Emergency First Aid.

COMPETENCY

Delegates are required to pass a theoretical and practical assessment of their competency in each of the above areas before being awarded with a course certificate, Delegates who pass the course assessment area also recorded on the OPITO Industry Database.

PRE REQUISITE

The T-FOET is open to persons who have a valid (in-date) OPITO-approved T-BOSIET or T-FOET or BOSIET or FOET certificate.

METHOD OF TRAINING

This course includes theoretical and practical components and will include the visual teaching aids, writing materials and provision of catering.

COURSE DURATION

One (1) day.

40% Theory / 60% Practical
