

# TRANSPORTATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS (IMDG CODE)

## COURSE AIM

To provide shore-side staff with the knowledge of documentation, packaging, segregation, stowage dangerous goods within container and on board ship.

## TARGET GROUP

This course is designed shore-side staff involved in dangerous goods transport

## COURSE CONTENT

At the end of the course, all delegates will be able to demonstrate knowledge and competency in the areas listed:

- Classify dangerous goods and identify proper shipping names of dangerous goods,
- Pack dangerous goods in package,
- Mark, label or placard dangerous goods,
- Pack/unpack Cargo Transport Units (CTUs),
- Prepare transport documents for dangerous goods,
- Offer dangerous goods for transport,
- Accept of dangerous goods for transport,
- Handle dangerous goods in transport,
- Prepare dangerous goods loading/stowage plans,
- Load/unload dangerous goods into/from ships,
- Carry of dangerous goods in transport,
- enforce or surveyor inspect for compliance with applicable rules and regulation, or
- are otherwise involved in the transport of dangerous goods as determined by the competent authority.
- General provisions of dangerous goods transport provisions,
- Description of the classes of dangerous goods; labelling, marking, placarding, packing, stowage, segregation and compatibility provisions,
- Description of the purpose and content of the dangerous goods transport documents (such as the Multimodal Dangerous Goods Form and the Container/Vehicle Packing Certificate),
- Description of available emergency response documents.

## COMPETENCY

Delegates are required to pass an assessment, a written or verbal examination of theory.

## PRE REQUISITE

There are no pre requisites for participation on this course.

## METHOD OF TRAINING

Classroom theory sessions followed by workshop exercises and will include the visual teaching aids, writing materials and provision of catering.

## COURSE DURATION

Two (2) days.
