

INTERNATIONAL SHIP & PORT FACILITY SECURITY CODE (ISPS CODE)

COURSE AIM

COMPETENCY

Delegates will be required to pass a practical assessment of skills, and a written or verbal examination of theory.

PRE REQUISITE

Classroom theory and workshop sessions followed by practical exercises and simulations and will include the visual teaching aids, writing materials and provision of catering.

COURSE DURATION

Two (2) days.
