

PORT FACILITY SECURITY OFFICER (PFSO)

COURSE AIM

To provide delegates full understanding of the ISPS Code and its requirements and have sound knowledge of the role and responsibilities of the Port Facility Security officer and laid out the ISPS Code.

The course ensures delegates fully understand how to:

- Manage Port Facility Security Plans,
- Effectively implement search processes and the wide range of security procedures,
- Implement the necessary control measure for each of the Security Levels,
- Develop and maintain access control measures,
- Conduct port security assessments and risk analysis.

TARGET GROUP

Every person designated as a Port Facility Officer (PFSO).

COURSE CONTENT

On completion, delegates will be able to demonstrate competence in the theory and practice of the following knowledge and skills:

- Develop, maintain and supervise the implementation of a Port Facility security plan,
- Assess Security risk, threat and vulnerability,
- Undertake regular inspections of the Port Facility to ensure that appropriate security measures are implemented and maintained,
- Ensure that Security equipment and systems, if any, operated, tested and calibrated, and
- Encourage Security awareness and vigilance.

COMPETENCY

Delegates will be required to pass a practical assessment of skills, a written or verbal examination of theory.

PRE REQUISITE

All PFSOs require to be an employee of a Port Facility.

METHOD OF TRAINING

This course includes theoretical and demonstration components and will include the visual teaching aids, writing materials and provision of catering.

COURSE DURATION

Two (2) days.
