

# SECURITY AWARENESS TRAINING FOR PORT FACILITY PERSONNEL WITH DESIGNATED SECURITY DUTIES

## COURSE AIM

To provide knowledge required for Port Facility personnel with designated security duties in connection with a Port Facility Plan (PFSP) to perform their duties in accordance with the requirements of Chapter XI-2 of SOLAS 74 as amended, the ISPS Code, the IMDG Code, the IMO/ILO Code of Practice on Security in Ports, and guidance contained in IMO MSC.1/Circ.1341.

## TARGET GROUP

All persons employed (or to be employed) by Port Facility operator and likely to be assigned specific duties in connection with the Port Facility Security Plan.

## COURSE CONTENT

The course will include the following subject:

- Introduction, Current security threats and patterns, Ship and port operations and conditions,
- Maritime Security Policy,
- Security Responsibilities,
- Port Facility Security Assessment,
- Security Equipment,
- Threat Identification, Recognition and Response,
- Port Facility Security Actions,
- Emergency Preparedness, drills and Exercises,
- Security Administration.

This course is designed around the IMO model course 3.24.

## COMPETENCY

Delegates will be required to pass a theoretical assessment of skills, a written or verbal examination of theory.

## PRE REQUISITE

All Port Facility personnel require to be designated (or to be designated) as an employee of a Port Facility.

## METHOD OF TRAINING

This course includes theoretical and demonstration components and will include the visual teaching aids, writing materials and provision of catering.

## COURSE DURATION

One (1) day.
